

2024 SUCCESS & IMPACT REPORT

Our mission is to help children and families to realize the possibilities of

their lives through foster care, adoption and mental health services.

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Here is a snapshot of Pathway Successes and Impact in 2024:

- 1,793 children, teens, and families received services to help them realize the possibilities of their lives.
- **395 hours** were dedicated by **72 volunteers** who helped plan fundraising events, assisted with clerical responsibilities, and made Pathway kids feel valued!
- **39 young adults** who aged out of foster care received support and resources by participating in the Bridges Program.
- 140 children slept safe in Pathway foster homes.

14 new foster homes were licensed with 94 homes available to care for children in foster care.

- 20 children were adopted by Pathway foster homes and now have forever families! This year, we expanded adoption finalizations to new counties, celebrating incredible families who navigated the complexities of foster care with patience, grace, and excitement to welcome children of all ages into their forever homes.
- 111 children and teens participated in prevention programs which reduces risk of needing mental health services and promotes resilience through support from trusted adults.
- 40 Teens attended TRUST Camp. On the last day of camp, countless teens were begging Pathway staff to extend the week, or to really think about making 2025 a whole week or even 10 days- they didn't want to leave! This is a testament to the memories and experiences Pathway teens will hold for the rest of their lives.
- 6 School Districts and over 500 students have therapists and case managers who help enhance student well-being, resilience, and success through accessible mental health support.
- 380 children ages birth through six years old in 7 schools and daycares collaborated with Pathway's Early Childhood Mental Health staff. Through early childhood mental health interventions, Pathway staff empower young children to manage emotions, build social skills, and thrive in school and life.
